**LONDON, England** -- I'm always blessed when I go to **Manor Park Christian Center (MPCC)** in **East London**. It is a praying congregation where the members care for one another, and where they believe God to hear and answer their prayers. What a testimony, smack in the middle of a predominantly Hindu and Moslem area.

While there, I had the privilege of preaching at the services on two Sundays, and a Monday evening Tamil service. I also participated in three care cells. Because of the richness of the worship I found it "easy" to preach, and the Lord was pleased to bring people forward at the appeal.

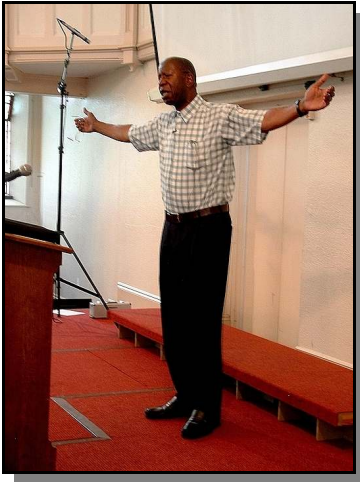

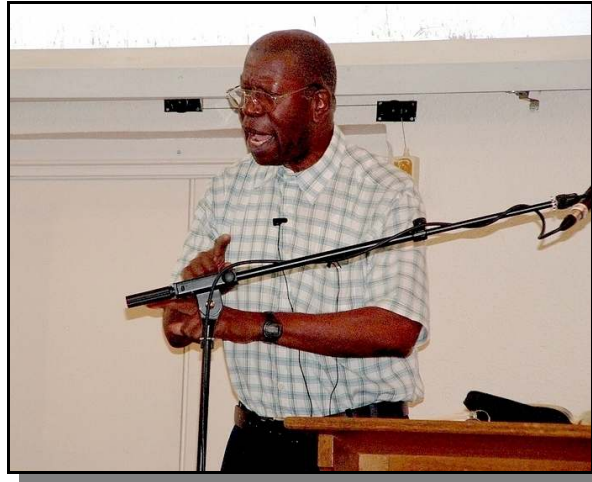
